How big is our industry?



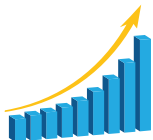
Newfoundland and Labrador produces 25% of Canada's conventional light crude oil



1.7 billion barrels have been produced so far That is roughly 270 billion litres of crude oil!



NL's offshore basins are 1.5 times the size of the US GULF OF MEXICO



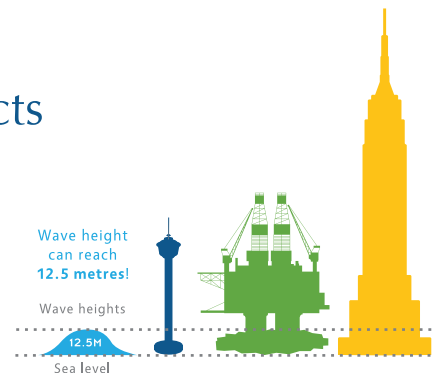
It is estimated that by 2033, our offshore will be producing 650,000 barrels of oil per day, resulting in 56,000 jobs in NL



It is estimated that there are 49.2 billion barrels of oil in less than 7% of our entire offshore

Interesting Facts

The Hibernia platform stands 224 meters high, which is half the height of New York's Empire State Building (449 m) and 33 metres taller than the Calgary Tower (191 m)



All offshore employees must finish 50 hours of safety training before going offshore...
